**Session A – Fall** (Sept. 19 – Dec. 12; see the calendar for weekly dates – 6:30-8:00 PM, in Greenleaf)

**Critical Thinking and Current Social Issues:** This topic will introduce students to basic argumentative concepts and tools, equipping them to intelligently engage with thoughts and ideas which either conflict with or support their Catholic faith. Skills learned in first part of this class will be used as seekers consider some of the current “hot topic” issues facing society today. (Repeated: Winter & Spring)

**Language of Faith:** This topic involves exposure to the various ways we experience and express the notion of “faith;” it is about beginning to learn the “language” of faith which is not always expressed in words. Seekers will be exposed to literature, art, music, architecture, and other ways faith is communicated. *NOTE: We will be taking a few field trips during this course therefore some sessions may be extended to allow for travel.* (Repeated: Winter & Spring)

**Church History - Part I:** This exciting series takes you through the major people, places, and events that make up the history of the Catholic Church. The series uses DVD and discussion. Some pre-reading before each session may be required.

**Session B - Winter** (Jan. 9 – Mar. 20; see the calendar for weekly dates dates – 6:30-8:00 PM, in Greenleaf)

**Critical Thinking and Current Social Issues:** This topic will introduce students to basic argumentative concepts and tools, equipping them to intelligently engage with thoughts and ideas which either conflict with or support their Catholic faith. Skills learned in first part of this class will be used as seekers consider some of the current “hot topic” issues facing society today. (Repeat of Fall and offered again in Spring)

**Language of Faith:** This topic involves exposure to the various ways we experience and express the notion of “faith;” it is about beginning to learn the “language” of faith which is not always expressed in words. Seekers will be exposed to literature, art, music, architecture, and other ways faith is communicated. *NOTE: We will be taking a few field trips during this course therefore some sessions may be extended to allow for travel.* (Repeat of Fall and offered again in Spring)

**Church History – Part II:** The series continues through the major people, places, and events that make up the history of the Catholic Church. (NOTE: Registration for and completion of Part I is a prerequisite.)

**Session C – Spring** (Mar. 27 – Jun. 5; see the calendar for weekly dates dates – 6:30-8:00 PM, in Greenleaf)

**Critical Thinking and Current Social Issues:** This topic will introduce students to basic argumentative concepts and tools, equipping them to intelligently engage with thoughts and ideas which either conflict of support their Catholic faith. Skills learned in first part of this class will be used as seekers consider some of the current “hot topic” issues facing society today. (Repeat of Fall and Winter)

**Language of Faith:** This topic involves exposure to the various ways we experience and express the notion of “faith;” it is about beginning to learn the “language” of faith which is not always expressed in words. Seekers will be exposed to literature, art, music, architecture, and other ways faith is communicated. *NOTE: We will be taking a few field trips during this course therefore some sessions may be extended to allow for travel.* (Repeat of Fall and Winer)

**Catholics @ Home:** This topic will introduce various practical aspects of the home life of a Catholic which are helpful to know, such as prayer spaces in the home, devotional objects, Liturgical season practices and traditions (Lent, Advent, etc.), a survey of Catholic movies and so on.
