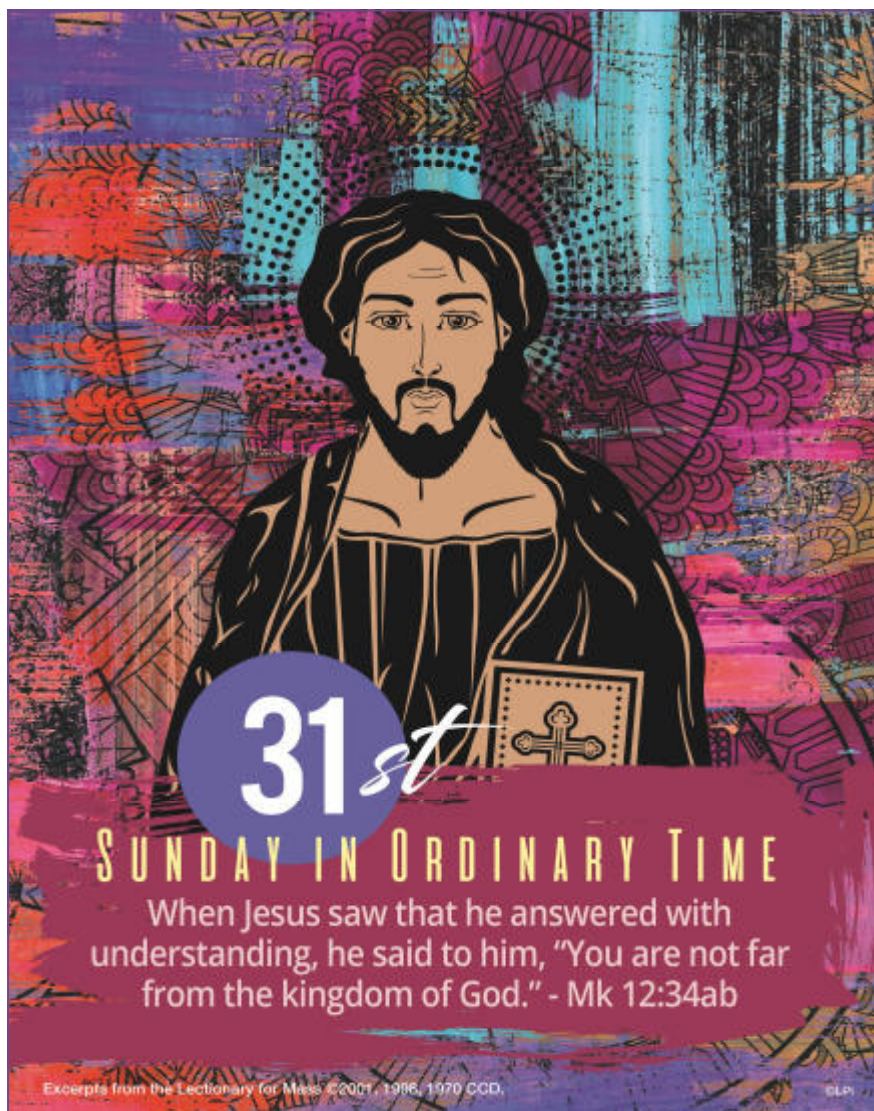

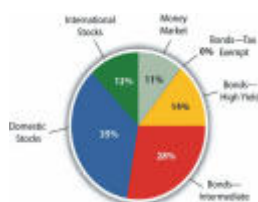
November: A Month of Remembrance

- ⇒ Septic Tank (AS) - TBD
- ⇒ Boiler Repair (WR) - \$990
- ⇒ Light Fixtures (WR) - \$1,650 (not including labor—TBD)
- ⇒ 25 Choir Hymnals (ALL) - \$777
