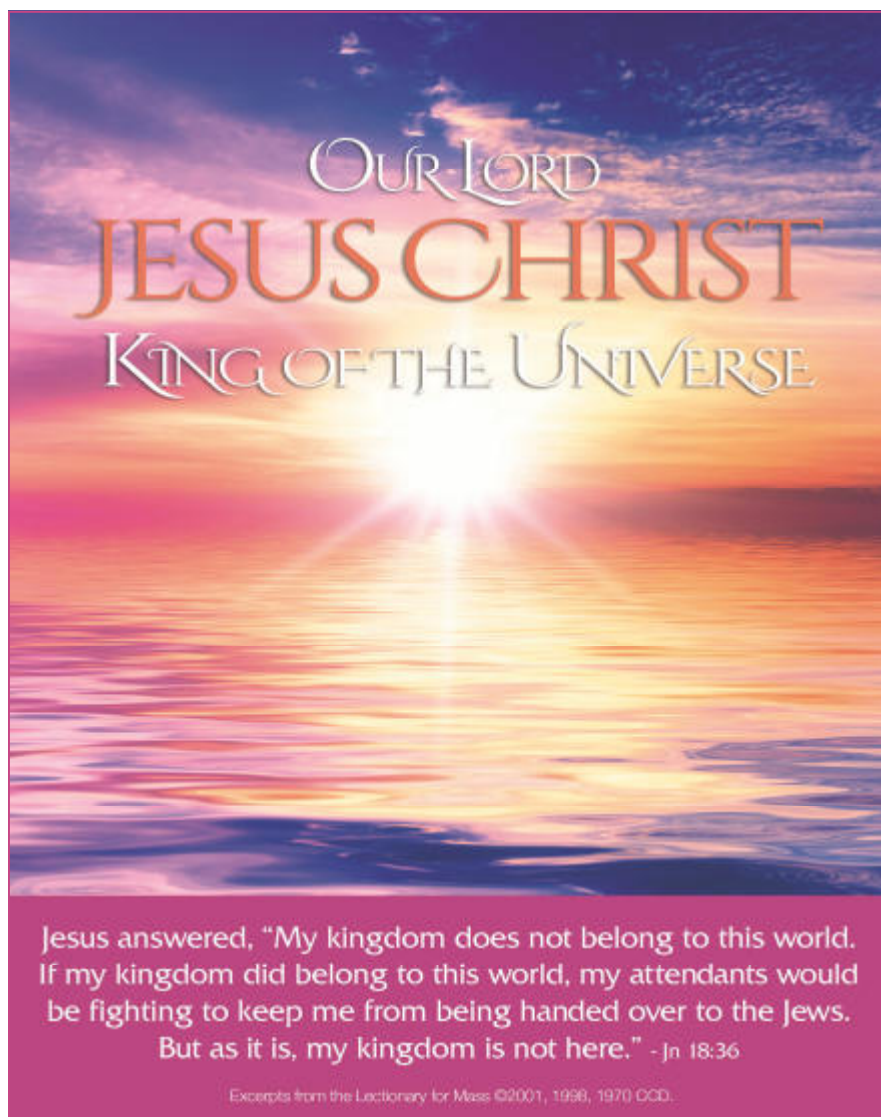

"TIDbits: Theological Ideas from the Deacons"

Are Catholics Superstitious?

Catholics are often accused of being "superstitious", because of medals and statues, etc. These things are not "superstitious" but "sacramental". Sacramentality means using the physical to connect to the spiritual. As physical beings, we must use physical things to connect with God. We call these "mediators" of the spiritual realm.

The only true mediator is Jesus Christ himself. He is able to mediate because He is both God and man. Jesus used physical things to connect spiritually. See John Chapter 9, where Jesus uses clay to cure a blind man. Jesus could have simply commanded healing, and He does in several places, but He clearly gives us the example of using the physical world to "mediate" the spiritual. The traditions of the Church make use of such "mediators" in order to be faithful to the example of our true mediator!
